M^r: John White, and with their or any two of their advice & consent to determin:
of what shall be propos'd to them, and what answers shall be given to such
propositions as they shall make to y^e: and the J^{ts}: Coll: Courcy, Christopher
Rousby, Coll: Col: Bourne, W^m: Stevens, and John White, that for matters of
this weight may be daily consid:ed, and the peace of the Province secured,
& with any tolerable fears of Honor it may be contriv'd.

8. You are to endeavor to engage Hassawap, Labaco, Tringassino, &
Amoungus to go as Mediators betwix: you and Unnacahosimon, in case he
will not com: personally to treat wth you, if all will not go: procure some
and if none of them will go: then engage the faithful: of your W^m: from
those Indians.

9. In case War be declared, & that Coll: Courcy, M^r: Christopher Rousby
Coll: Col: Bourne, M^r: W^m: Stevens, & M^r: John White or any two of them
cannot attend the Service, you are to choos: a Council out of yo: own
officers, and by the advice of them or the major: of them to govern yo:

injure the English, and that they either drive up the Southern Indians that
came wth Cacatass, or force them immediately to depart the Province. ~
