

(4) They do not think that it will be prejudicial to any
person, provided that due notice be given, hereof
and particular Expresses sent by the County
on 1. Occasion. — Whereupon it was advised
and resolved accordingly, a Proclamation
issued to provoke the Assembly unto the 25th of
April Instant requiring them to meet at the City
And also her Majesty's Will to adjourn the Provincial
Court to the third Tuesday of May next ensuing
And ordered that particular Expresses be immediatly
sent on this Occasion. —
