Nicholas White agrees with the Governor and Council to make and completely furnish two hundred stand of Arms in a Workman like manner at the rate of Fifty Shillings Currency for each stand, the Governor and Council supplying the said Nicholas White with Barrels, Locks, Bayonets, Mounting, Steel for Rammers and Iron for Drutching, at the rate of Forty eight stands per Month till the Delivery of the whole Number contracted for and have also advanced two hundred and fifty Pounds part of the Price on giving Bond with good Security to comply with this Contract.

May: Nath. Smith, You are to enlist 66 of the Madhouses in Baltimore including non commissioned Officers, into the Continental Service agreeable to the Resolution of the General Assembly paying them twenty Dollars each the Continental Bounty —

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt. Thomas Walker two hundred and thirteen Pounds, ten Shillings and nine pence per Account passed the Board.

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Quym twenty two Pounds, Ten Shillings amount of account passed the Board.

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Quym five Pounds three shillings and six pence for the use of Thomas Snowden per account passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Quym Thirty Pounds for the use of William Whetcroft due him per account passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Matthews twenty eight Pounds, sixteen shillings and six pence to pay for 33 Gallons of Whiskey bought by him for the Galley Independence.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Matthews four hundred and twenty nine Pounds, nine Shillings and Ten pence due on account including the Pay roll of the Galley Independence. passed by the Board of Accounts.
