

Capt. Conway, You are to deliver the Sloop Molly with her Appurtenances to Capt. Daniel Dethon who goes Master of her, taking his Receipt on her Inventory, the negro man you left onboard you are to send up in the Boat in which you go down.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Col. Gist for the use of Richard Loughman one of the recruiting Officers in Baltimore County & to be delivered over to him one hundred and thirty two pounds due to him for recruiting twenty two men at six pounds each

That the said Treasurer pay to Col. Gist, one thousand Dollars of the money lately sent by Congress for the recruiting Service and two thousand Dollars of the money of this State amounting in the whole to three thousand Dollars to pay the bounty of Recruits already raised ^{and to be raised} for the third Regiment & to be charged to that Regiment

That Mr. Crysall deliver to Capt. Daniel Dethon one Barrel Turpentine five Barrels Pork, two Barrels Beef and one Barrel Tallow all 120 to for the Sloop Molly.

Richard Sprigg Esquire resigns his Office of Chancellor to this State by delivering the Seal to the Governor in Council and at the same Time declares that he did by that Act of delivering the Seal resign his Office of Chancellor of this State which Resignation was accepted

John Rogers Esquire is appointed Chancellor of this State and the Seal of this State thereupon delivered to him by the Governor in Council, Whereupon the said John Rogers qualified as Chancellor before the Governor by taking the several Oaths prescribed by the Constitution and Form of Government and subscribing a Declaration of his Belief in the Christian Religion and also the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State and the Oath of Chancellor prescribed by the Act of Assembly

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Captains Benjamin Matthews one hundred pounds for the use of the Galley Independence on Account
