Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Henry Baldwin Quarter
Master to the 3^d Regiment One hundred and fifty Pounds due him by a Resolva
of the General Assembly, Gen^l Smallwood having in his Ord^r of the 17th Inst^t
requested the same to be paid him and that he had not received it.

Saturday 27th March 1779

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Simon Ratalack, three
hundred and twenty nine Pounds, two shillings and three pence due to Ridge and
Ratalack per Act passed by the Aud^t Gen^l

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to John Robinson of the
first Regiment, one pair of Shoes

Sunday 29th March 1779

Present as on Saturday

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to John Mason a nine
Month Soldier in the 5th Reg^t Discharged, the amt^t of Twenty three Pounds
ten shillings in Cloathing & 1 Blanket, Army Evans a q^r M^o Sold^r in the 7th Reg^t
Disch^d the amt^t of Twenty one Pounds, three shillings & six Pence in Cloathing and
1 Blanket, & Isaac Green a q^r M^o Sold^r in the 3^d Reg^t Discharged the amount
of Eleven Pounds, fifteen shillings & six Pence in Cloathing, due them by an Act
of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Philamon Griffith one hundred
thirty six Pounds, seventeen shillings & six pence for the use of Saw Griffith per Act
passed by the Aud^t Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Smoot, sixty two Pounds, nine
shillings & four pence for the use of Joseph Smalls jun^r, per Act passed by Aud^t Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to James Buie Esquire, Two hundred and
Eighty five Pounds, due him for attⁿ in General to this day Inclusive

That the said Treasurer pay to John Belt, Lieut. of the 4th Mass^y
Reg^t in the Continental Service, One hundred & fifty Pounds due him by a
Resolva of the Gen^l Assembly
