the amt<sup>t</sup> of Twenty one Pounds in Cloathing & 1 Blanket, William Wason a 9 mo.  
Soldier in the 3<sup>d</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> Disch<sup>d</sup> the amt<sup>t</sup> of Eighteen Pounds, three shillings & six  
pence in Cloathing & 1 Blanket, due them by an Act of Assembly to procure  
Troops for the American Army
