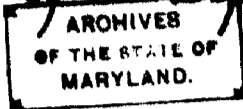


Thursday 1st April 1779

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Hyde Two hundred and Eighty six Pounds, fifteen shillings for the use of William Godsmith due him & ac^t. paid by the Dep^y Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Beach & Maybrey one hundred and forty one Pounds Thirteen shillings & six pence due him for ac^t. paid by the Dep^y Aud^r. and also the further Sum of Fifty Pounds on Account.



After three Days spent in examining Witnesses on both Sides, a Memorial presented to the Govern^r & Council by James Drane, Marsh & Meind Duwall, Benjamin Bell, Joseph Duwall, and the Drane jun^r against James & Kullikin praying that he might be removed from the Magistracy of Prince Georges County. It was recommended by his Excellency & the Council to the Parties, to make up and settle all Differences subjecting between them and insure to live in Peace. Whereupon the Memorialists agree to withdraw the Memorial and the the Subscribers agree that all Differences & Disputes which have heretofore subsisted between us be buried in Oblivion and that we will not revive the same and that this shall be published in the News paper.

Saturday 3rd April 1779

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Friend Sixty Pounds, due him for Account paid by the Dep^y & Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Amis seven Pounds, ten shillings due him for buying a Sotum for ac^t. paid by the Dep^y & Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw, Three hundred and two Pounds, sixteen shillings for Account paid by the Aud^r Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Johnson nine Pounds, fifteen shillings for Account paid by the Dep^y & Aud^r.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut. Bagnall of Capt. Campbells Company two pair of Shoes.

Monday 5th April 1779

Commissions of Letters of Marque & Reprisal issued to Joseph Darity Commander of the Sloop General Gates, 50 Tons Burthen, mounting 8. Cannon Guns, 2 Swivels & 8 Small Arms belonging to David H. Cunningham & Arch. Gamble of Baltimore and also to Benjamin Tatum Commander of the Schooner General Gates 30 Tons Burthen, mounting 8 Swivel Guns and 9 Small Arms, belonging to Hugh Young Com^d of Baltimore.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Richard Brogden Thirty six Pounds, two shillings and nine pence due him & ac^t. paid by the Dep^y & Aud^r.

Commission of Letters of Marque & Reprisal issued to Alexander Murray Com^d of the Brig Columbia, 10 Can. Guns, 6 Howitz & 12 small arms, belonging to Samuel & Robert Purviance of Baltimore.
