

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Giles one hundred and fifty Pounds Continental and fifty Pounds of the new Emission to be delivered over to Lt^o Henry Hallingsworth on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson just one hundred and eight Pounds for forty eight pounds of Tallow purchased of Miles and Bass for the use of the State Boats Dolphin and Platan and also the further Sum of seventy three Pounds two Shillings and six pence advanced by him to an Express going to the Patent Office when the Enemy was up Patuxent.

Monday 20th November 1780.

Ordered That the Armourer deliver to Commodore Tibbet two hundred three pounds and two British Flage and also to Capt William Mordaunt of the Dolphin twenty five pound powder, one quire Lon. Paper, ten pikes, and four doz Jewell Shot, - to Capt Gilbert Mordaunt of the Platan, twenty pound Cannon & two pound Musket powder, eight pikes and one Quire Cartridge paper on Account and to Capt Francis Jewell two Canteens on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Commodore Tibbet six pair of Slops to Capt Francis Jewell three Camp Kettles and also to Lieut John Lane of the Third Regt Cloth and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two Shirts on Account.

That the Sprung Commissary deliver to Commodore Tibbet twelve hews and hane to Lieut James McFaden, Ten gallons of Rum, thirty two pounds of sugar and eighteen pounds of Coffee due him to the 31st October inclusive. - to Lieut John Lane of the 3rd Regiment thirteen and an half Gallons of Rum and twenty four and an half pounds of Coffee deficiency of Stores due to the 31st Oct. inclusive.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut James McFaden eight Pounds, eight shillings of the new Emission in lieu of Three hundred and thirty six Pounds per Account passed by the Quar. Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Orms Watkins five Dollars of the same Emission in lieu of seventy five pounds due him per Ac^t passed by the Dep^t and.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Benjamin Price fifty seven pound ten Shillings due him per Ac^t passed by the Dep^t and.

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Munroe four hundred & fifty five Pounds ten shillings due him per Ac^t passed by the Dep^t and.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Lane of the 3rd Regiment three pound twelve Shillings and nine pence of the new Emission in lieu of one hundred and forty five pounds ten shillings due him per Ac^t passed by the Dep^t and.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen Esq. fifteen Dollars of the new Emission and two hundred and twelve pounds ten shillings font^l on Ac^t.

That Mr. Bullen, immediately Report the condition of the Horses he has purchased for the State, agreeably to the directions of this Board heretofore given him that the Resolution of the General Assembly may be forthwith carried into Execution.
