

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Giles one hundred  
fifty Pounds continental and fifty Pounds of the new Emision to be delivered over to  
Capt Henry Hollingsworth on Accout.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson junr. one hundred and eight  
Pounds for forty eight pounds of Callow purchased of Hales and Bush for the use of the  
State Boats Dolphin and Platn and also the further sum of Twenty three Pounds  
two Shillings and six pence advanced by him to an Express going to the Island  
when the Enemy were up Patagot.

Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November 1780.

Ordered That the Armourer deliver to Commodore Tibbet two hundred three pounds  
and two British Flags and also to Capt William Middleton of the Dolphin twenty two  
pound powder, one quoit bar Paper, ten pikes, and four dozen Jewel shot. — to Capt.  
Gilbert Middleton of the Platn, Twenty pound Cannon & two pounds Musket powder, eight  
pikes and one Dozen Cartridge paper on Accout and to Capt Francis Revelly five  
Canteens on Accout.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Commodore Tibbet five pair of Slugs  
to Capt Francis Revelly three Camp Knives and also to Lieut John Fair of the Third Regt  
Cloth and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths and Armor for two Shirts on Accout.

That the Young Commissary deliver to Commodore Tibbet twelve lemons and limes  
to Lieut James McFadon, Ten gallons of Rum, thirty two pounds of sugar and eighteen  
pounds of Coffee due him to the 31<sup>st</sup> October inclusiv<sup>e</sup>. — to Lieut John Fair of the 3<sup>d</sup>  
Regiment thirteen and an half Gallons of Rum and Twenty four and an half pounds of Coffee  
deficiency of Stores due to the 31<sup>st</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup> inclusiv<sup>e</sup>.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut James McFadon Eight Pounds, eight  
Shillings of the New Emision in lieu of Three hundred and Thirty five Pounds over Accout  
paid by the Comd<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Oliver Watkins Two Dollars of the same  
Emision when of Twenty five pounds due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the Depy And<sup>r</sup>

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Benjamin Price fifty Seven pounds  
ten Shillings due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the Depy And<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Murray Four hundred & fifty five  
Pounds ten shillings due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the Depy And<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Fair of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment  
Three pounds twelve Shillings and nine pence of the New Emision in lieu of one hundred  
and forty five pounds ten shillings due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the Depy And<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen Esq<sup>r</sup> Fifteen Dollars of  
the New Emision and two hundred and twelve pounds ten shillings fift<sup>th</sup> on Acc<sup>t</sup>

That Mr Bullen immediately Report the condition of the Horses  
he has purchased for the State, agreeably to the directions of this Board heretofore given  
him that the Resolution of the General Assembly may be forthwith carried into Effect.
