By the Petition of John. N. Diggins of Caroline County it appears that a certain Robert Cozier was presented by the Grand Jury of the said County for retailing Spiritous Liquors without licence and at March Term 1798 was fined the sum of six pounds on each presentment amounting in the whole to twenty four pounds for which the Petitioner became security.
