His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy Gresham appeared in the Council Room.

Thursday November the 26. 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Lewis Duwall Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy Gresham.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Beckin Esquire Editor of the American the sum of forty seven Dollars and seventy five Cents for printing done for the State as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Resolved that the Ammunition at Frederick Town deliver to Captain William H. Nicholson seventy two Stand of Arms complete for the use of his Volunteer Company.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Gunn Esquire six hundred Dollars for six Months Salary as Printer to the State due the first Instant.

Resolved that the Proceedings of the Council shall be regularly entered on a Journal each day, and that on the succeeding day previous to any other act, the same shall be read over by the Clerk, and signed by the Governor or the Member of the Council presiding, before which any Member may move to reconsider any part thereof which may not have been carried into execution and the same shall be considered as subject to alteration by a subsequent vote of the Council.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other offices of annual appointment till to Morrow.
