The Honourable James Mabb a Counsellor elect appeared in the Council Room, and was qualified as such agreeably to the Constitution and laws of this State before Richard Murchin Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County, by taking repeating and subscribing the several oaths and the declaration prescribed for that purpose as well as the oath to support the Government of the United States. Certificate there of filed. The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Lewis Duwall Thomas. W. Hall and James Mabb.

The Council resumed the consideration of the Appointment of Justices of the Peace and other Officers directed by the Constitution and laws to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till to Morrow.

William Orrell was appointed Surveyor of Caroline County vice Henry Whiteley resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Moses W. Nubitt was appointed Coroner of Dorchester County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the amount at Fudrich Town deliver to Captain George E. Mitchell seventy two Stand of Arms complete for the use of his Volunteer Company.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other Officers of annual appointment till Monday.
