

March 8th 1820.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Show pay to the order of John S. Meyer, Four hundred and forty eight dollars for one year ground rent of Tobacco Warehouse lot purchased of Moses Sheppard, to 15th August next & payable 15th inst.

March 10.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Show, pay to the order of Charles H. Blount, Five dollars twenty five Cents for publishing Governor Martin's proclamation for the apprehension of John Taylor Kidd. (payable by Endorsement to J. H. Blount)

March 11.

Ordered that the Treasurer for the Western Show pay to the order of John B. Spencer, Editor of the Centreville Times, twenty six dollars for publishing public laws.

March 12.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Show, pay to the order of Edward J. Hoak, four dollars seventy five Cents for two pen knives for the use of the Executive.

March 15th.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Nolle Prosequi to William Tyler of Lewis of Dorchester County, who was presented by the Grand Jury of said County at October Term 1829. for an assault on John Docks by snapping a gun at him. (see pardon record)

March 23rd

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Show pay to the order of Henry Thompson, Thirty two dollars twenty nine Cents to be accounted for.

March 25th.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Nolle prosequi, to the Hon. Charles W. Hanson, for an assault on his wife Rebecca, D. Hanson. (see pardon record)
