

Wednesday November 25th 1835.

The following orders were issued by His Excellency the Governor upon the Demand, and in formation and evidence therein mentioned viz.

The State of Maryland, To the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore City & County Greeting: Whereas, it appears from authentic documents certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency Peter A. Broun Governor of the State of New Jersey, that a certain Thomas Jones stands charged upon oath with having committed a Robbery, at New Brunswick in the County of Middlesex in the said State of New Jersey, and that the said Thomas Jones has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is now confined in Jail in the City of Baltimore. And Whereas the said Peter A. Broun Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Thomas Jones of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Peter Runyon his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of New Jersey for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand, to order and direct the Surrender of the said fugitive, and I do hereby order and direct, that you, forthwith, deliver the said Thomas Jones, if he is in your custody, or within your bailiwick, to the said Peter P. Runyon agent as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive. — for all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
