Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,  
That our Senators and Representatives in Congress of  
the United States, be earnestly and respectfully requested  
to urge upon the General Government, the necessity and  
propriety of making as soon as possible, some ar-  
rangement by treaty or otherwise, with the Peruvian  
Government by which the present monopoly in the  
sale of Guano in this State, and other States of the  
Union, may be removed, and the Agricultural inter-  
ests of our Country thereby be greatly promoted.  
Resolved, That the Governor of this State, be  
requested to transmit a copy of the foregoing Resolu-  
tion to the Senators and Representatives in Congress  
from this State."
