

surer of the State of Maryland, that the property and estate of the University of Maryland shall never be disposed of or converted to any other use than that of Medical Science, or the Arts and Sciences generally, without the consent of the General Assembly of Maryland, and that any act, deed or conveyance of the said corporation to a different intent, or to different uses shall be null and void, and that the Legislature may then take possession of, and control, and direct the said property and estate for the purpose of promoting General Science.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That the Regents of the University of Maryland shall under their corporate seal, and the signatures of their Provost, and several Professors, make an annual report on the first day of January, or within ten days thereafter, of the condition and prospects of said Institution, stating among other things the number of Students therein instructed, and an enumeration of the different departments of science therein taught, with a full and detailed statement of the accounts thereof, showing the proper receipts and expenditures of said Regents.
