

the passage of the act establishing the Lottery system on its present basis, when the sale of all foreign tickets was expressly prohibited by law.

A tabular statement shewing the amount of monies received by the Lottery system, and paid into the Treasury of the Western Shore of Maryland for the following years, by the commissioners of Lotteries, together with contingent expenses and officers, compensation for the said years. The first four years being an exhibit of the operations under the old system, and presented, in order that the receipts and expenditures under the old, may be contrasted with those under the new or improved system authorised by the act of Assembly, December session 1831, as devised by the commissioners of Lotteries and adopted on their recommendation.
