**OF**  
**THE TITLES OF THE LAWS,**  
**MADE AND PASSED AT**  
**DECEMBER SESSION, 1838.**

No. 1 An act to empower the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to sell the market house, in West Patrick street, and apply the proceeds to the erection of public pumps in Bentz Town, in Frederick.

2 An act to authorise Thomas Dowden, present sheriff of Allegany county, to bond as sheriff of said county, at any time before the first day of February next, and to authorise the clerk of said county to receive and record said bond.

3 An act, entitled, an act to make valid a deed from George Fisher, of Carroll county, (late Frederick county) to John Nankeville, of said county.

4 An act to change the name of State street in the city of Baltimore.

5 A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for electing commissions for Allegany county, and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at December session 1829, chapter 25.

6 An act to secure to citizens of Allegany county, the right of trial for debt under warrant in the election district only in which the party so sued may reside.

7 An act for the relief of Samuel Jordan.

8 A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to establish Magistrates' Courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, passed March 1836, chapter 201.

9 An act to establish two additional election districts in Baltimore county, and for the general arrangement of the whole, as far as appellation and numbers are concerned.

10 An act to authorise the clerk of Frederick county court to approve the bond of James Carlin.

11 An act for the benefit of David Rohrer, in Washington county.

12 An act to consolidate the sixth and eleventh election districts of Somerset county.
