

- 162 An act to divorce John Smith of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Margaret Smith.
- 163 An act to authorise an alteration in the location of the public road, from the city of Annapolis to the city of Baltimore, through the lands of Leonard Iglehart, John T. Hodges, Nicholas B. Worthington and Absalom Bealmear and wife.
- 164 An act to authorise Edward H. Pendleton, to remove into this State three slaves.
- 165 An act to divorce Catharine Yustena Barron, of Baltimore city, from her husband Joseph F. Barron.
- 166 An act relating to Poplar District, one of the primary school districts, in Frederick county.
- 167 An act in relation to the Frederick county school fund.
- 168 An act to authorise the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to extend the limits of direct taxation.
- 169 An act to authorise Philemon Warfield, collector of taxes, in the second collection district of Anne Arundel county, further time to complete his collections.
- 170 An act to introduce the culture of the Mulberry trees, and raising of Silk, at the Alms House, in Kent county.
- 171 An act for the relief of James B. Bounds, and Sarah Ann his wife, of the city of Baltimore.
- 172 An act to authorise Somerset R. Watters, David Shindler, and Peter Schlosser, Trustees of Beallville School House, to lease the same to the Trustees of Beallville Primary School District No. 8.
- 173 An act to authorise the building a pile bridge over Cucheles Gut, at Cucheles point, in Baltimore county.
- 174 An act to lay out, and open a road in Prince George's county.
- 175 An act to divorce Maria Danskin of Baltimore city, from her husband Washington A. Danskin.
- 176 An act in favor of David Koons, of Washington county.
- 177 An act to authorise John Kinzer, and Surat D. Warfield, of Frederick county, to sell a certain school house, known by the name of the Beaver Dam school house, and the lot and dwelling house attached thereto.
- 178 An act to extend the time of William Frush, collector of taxes in Baltimore county, to complete his collection.
- 179 A supplement to an act, entitled an act, for the promotion of internal improvements, passed at the adjourned May session of 1836, chapter 395.
