

Maryland, authenticated by the oaths of the proper engineers, clerks or other officers, tabular statements or reports shewing the quantity and character of the work done, contrasted with that remaining to be executed, and showing the progress made, and also full and particular accounts of money expended and debts remaining, and of income and revenue, for the information of the authorities of the said State of Maryland, and that the adoption of this last resolve be also communicated to the said treasurer under the corporate seal of the said company and the signatures of its President and Directors as aforesaid.

NOW THIS DEED made this twenty-third day of April, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-five, between the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company of the one part, and the State of Maryland of the other part, WITNESSETH, and it is hereby certified to the treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland, that the said Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company by its stockholders in general meeting as aforesaid, has approved, assented and agreed to, and by these presents doth approve, assent and agree to, the several provisions of the aforesaid act, so far as the same is applicable to the said company—and it is hereby further witnessed, that the said Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, for and in consideration of the provisions made by the aforesaid act for the benefit of the said company, and in consideration also of the sum of five dollars current money to the said company now paid by the said treasurer on behalf of the said State, and by the said company hereby acknowledged to have been received, hath granted, bargained and sold, conveyed, assigned, transferred and pledged, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell, convey, assign, transfer and pledge unto the said State of Maryland, all and singular the lands and tenements, capital stock, estates and securities, goods and chattels, property and rights, now or at any time hereafter to be acquired, and the nett tolls and revenues of the said company—to have and to hold the aforesaid real and personal property, and other the premises hereby conveyed or intended so to be, with the appurtenances, unto the State of Maryland, to its own proper use and behoof, and to and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever—to be void notwithstanding, if the said company shall in good faith and fully comply with, fulfil and perform, the requests of the fourth, fifth, sixth and nineteenth sections of the enactment aforesaid and its several stipulations herein—And the said Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, for the considerations aforesaid engaging, doth hereby especially promise to, and covenant with, the State of Maryland, and oblige itself and the President and Directors thereof and their successors, to pay to the said treasurer in the manner provided in the said fourth section, the whole interest and principal of the loan or loans which shall be made to the said company in pursuance of the said act, to pay to the said treasurer the whole of its nett revenues, and the proceeds of the sales or leases of the whole of the property hitherto or hereafter to be
