

Inter. 12. In what way has the instalments on the stock standing in the name of John P. Langford been paid? state particularly whether it has been done by the knowledge priority and consent of the administrator on his estate.

Answer to 12th Inter. The instalments due on the fifty shares of stock, standing in the name of John P. Langford, have been paid up to, and including the fourth instalment; the fifth instalment has not been paid, in consequence of his death, these fifty shares are not included in the number stated as paid to the fifth instalment inclusive.

Inter. 13. Has the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company received any money from the Treasurer of Maryland since the last legislature? If yea, what amount?

Answer to 13th Inter. The Treasurer of the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company has received from the Treasurer of State of Maryland fifteen thousand dollars in the month of July last, this payment was made in part of a draft on said Treasurer, for thirty thousand dollars?

Inter. 16th. Has the board of directors passed any resolution or other proceedings, directing suit to be instituted against any one or more of the persons who have forfeited their stock, for the purpose of compelling payments? Have any such suits been instituted?
