The Committee of Ways and Means, respectfully report that from the annual statement of the Treasurer for the Western Shore, submitted to this Legislature it appears,

That there remained in the Treasury on the 1st, December, 1839, a balance of \$61,465 23
That in the year ending 1st December, 1840, he received 1,554,402 57

—————
Making a total of 1,615,867 80

That he has expended during the year, ending 1st December, 1840, 1,557,452 04

—————
Which left in the Treasury on that day a balance of 58,414 86

It also appears that the probable receipts during the current year, are estimated at 306,905 53

—————
Making for the service of the year a total of 365,320 39

The probable expenses for the year are estimated at 845,915 03

And if to this be added the balance of appropriations due 1st December, 1840, and which are now payable, 709,57 18
