379. An act relating to constables and to estates and fees due to deceased constables and for other purposes.

380. An act to authorise Joseph Everstine late collector of the State and county taxes in and for Allegany county, to complete his collections of said taxes.

381. An act making it a criminal offence for any person or persons maliciously to set on fire any fence or fencing any straw, or stack or stacks of straw or any hay or mowed grass or other grass.

382. A supplement to an act passed December session, 1844, chapter 232, entitled, an act to establish a primary school in election district No. 2, called school district No. 1.

383. An act to make valid certain deeds from John Crouse and wife, and David Crouse, and wife to Christopher Wisner, and John Beggs, and wife, to Richard Beggs, of Carroll county.

384. An act for the benefit of the trustees of the Catholic Cathedral Church of Baltimore.

385. An act to repeal the fourth and fifth sections of an act entitled, an act to prevent illegal voting in this State, passed at December session 1844, chapter 309.

386. An act to allow Henry P. Geoghegan, collector of county taxes of Talbot county, further time to complete his collections.

387. An act for the relief of sundry poor persons in the several counties therein mentioned.

388. An act to divorce Eliza Jane Dowling from her husband William Dowling.

389. An act to allow Henry P. Geoghegan, late collector of State taxes of Talbot county, further time to complete his collections.

390. An act to enable Henry M. Jamison, of Wheeling to sell or hire a negro boy, in the State of Maryland.

391. A supplement to the act imposing a tax on commissions allowed to executors and administrators, passed at December session, 1844, chapter 184.

392. An act to allow Thomas Lusby, former sheriff and collector of Kent county further time to complete his collections.

393. An act to extend the trial by jury to certain cases.

394. An act for the relief of Francis Stephens, late sheriff of Calvert county.

395. An act for the protection of the public buildings in Allegany county, and also to provide for their completion.

396. An act to make valid the last will and testament of Eurith Cockey, of Carroll county.

397. An act to repeal the 21st, and 22nd sections of the act of 1801, chapter 63, entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco.
