## BY THE COMMITTEE ON CLAIMS.

Your Committee report that they have examined the proceedings and documents of D. Claude, Treasurer of the State of Maryland, and find, from an account settled to 1st December, 1849, by the Committee of Claims of the last General Assembly, there then remained in the Treasury, four hundred and eighty-four thousand, eight hundred and ninety-two dollars and ninety-six cents. That it appears to your committee, by the accounts of the said Treasurer, he has received, from 1st December 1849, to 1st December 1850, \$1,227,986.24.
