

230. An act to lay off and locate a public road in Howard county.

231. An act to provide for the formation of corporations for moral, scientific, literary, dramatic, agricultural, or charitable purposes, and for the incorporation of uniformed volunteer companies, fire engine or hose companies, and benevolent, beneficial and musical associations.

232. An act to authorise and empower Nathaniel Wiley and John W. Bowman, of Kent county, to sell and dispose of a tract or parcel of land in said county, and the proceeds to be applied towards building a church in said county.

233. An act to authorise the County Commissioners of Talbot, Queen Anne's and Caroline counties to levy a sum for paying the crier of the Circuit Court in said counties.

234. An act making valid certain proceedings of Absalom W. Sparks, late a constable of Kent county, and authorising a deed of certain lands therein mentioned, to be made to William Lamb.

235. An act to prevent the circulation of notes or bills of a denomination less than five dollars.

236. An act for the relief of Henry Snurr, Jr., of Frederick county.

237. An act incorporating a company to make the Bloomingdale Turnpike Road on the bed of the present road, leading from the blacksmith shop of John Slack, on the Franklin Turnpike Road, in Baltimore county, to intersect the Windsor Mill Road, at a point at or near the city line, and running thence on the bed of the Windsor Mill Road to a point known as Wells' Corner.

238. An act to alter and change the name of William Henry Shipley, of Carroll county, to William Henry Gorsuch.

239. An act to extend the civil jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace, and to prescribe their powers and duties.

240. An act to amend an act entitled, an act for the preservation of fish in the waters of Talbot, Dorchester and Caroline counties, passed December session, 1843, chapter 142.

241. An act to alter and amend an act incorporating the Maryland Institute for the Promotion of the Mechanic Arts, passed December session 1849, chapter 114, so as to allow said institute to establish a department of Analytic Chemistry, and confer diplomas upon graduates thereof.

242. An act to amend an act entitled, an act authorising the appointment of an inspector and wood corder at Clarksville and its vicinity, in Baltimore county, passed at December session, 1847, chapter 251.

243. An act to provide for the re-building of the State's wharf, on Frederick street dock, and the repairing of numbers one, two and four State Tobacco Warehouses, in the city of Baltimore.

244. An act to authorise the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to appoint a proper person to superintend the
