

278. An act to authorise the enlargement of Mount Olivet Cemetery, and for the better protection of the same.

279. An act to create a new election district in Frederick county, out of parts of the Creagerstown, Emmittsburg and Hauver's districts, in said county.

280. An act to authorise the conveyance to the trustees of the Franklinville Presbyterian Church, in Baltimore county.

281. An act extending the powers of certain Commissioners, appointed by an act of the General Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, chapter three hundred and eighty-eight, to create an additional free school in election district, number five, in Prince George's county.

282. An act to make valid a deed from Elizabeth Wilson and others to C. C. Culler and others.

283. An act empowering the County Commissioners of Carroll county, and the County Commissioners of Howard county, to levy a sufficient sum of money to build a bridge over the Patapsco Falls, at or near Woodbine.

284. An act to authorise and empower the County Commissioners of Allegany county to sell the alms house property, belonging to said county.

285. An act incorporating the Federal Hill Steam Ferry Company.

286. An act entitled, an act to compensate counsel engaged in behalf of the State of Maryland, in the case of the United States vs. Castner Hanway and others.

287. An act for the benefit of the Public Schools of the City of Baltimore.

288. An act to regulate the issuing of license to free negroes and mulattoes, and to prevent their employment as clerks in Somerset, Worcester and Anne Arundel counties.

289. An act to authorise the County Commissioners for Dorchester county to adopt and use as evidence of the ownership of assessable property in the said county, for the purpose of taxation, the former assessment list of 1851, now in the hands of the collectors.

290. An act to provide for the per diem allowance of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Anne Arundel county.

291. An act declaring it a misdemeanor to remove sand or gravel from the shores of the Potomac river.

292. An act allowing to Nancy Coward, widow of William Coward, a Lieutenant in the American Revolution, a pension, and appropriating a sum of money for the payment thereof.

293. An act to incorporate the Mount Vernon Hotel Company in the City of Baltimore.

294. An act to incorporate the St. Mary's Savings Institution.

295. A supplement to an act entitled, an act to erect a town in Talbot county, by the name of St. Michaels, passed at November session, 1804, chapter 82.
