

3rd interrogatory. Answers and says he has not, except as an Attorney.

Cross interrogatories were propounded to Mr. Tarr by the directors.

1st interrogatory. Answers and says he did not know of any on the part of the stockholders, but advised them as their Attorney that the bank could go into operation upon the payment of forty thousand dollars, which sum to his knowledge was paid in.

2d interrogatory. Answers and says he has. Mr. McGonigal, Mr. Nuttle and Dr. Rossette each, on different occasions have. If he would act with Mr. James L. Martin, that he should be compensated for the same out of the funds of the bank. Those conversations took place some time in August. These gentlemen in their conversation stated that the bank was a nuisance and held by foreigners, and that it ought to be broken up as it was no benefit to the community.

3rd interrogatory. Answers and says he did not.

4th interrogatory. Answers and says it did.

5th interrogatory. Answers and says he did sometime in July or August.

6th interrogatory. Answers and says sometime in July or August he stated in regard to Mr. Bradley's signing notes.

Mr. M. A. Bradley being duly affirmed by Mr. Thomas J. Earrickson, a Justice of the Peace in and for Caroline county, State of Maryland, as a witness on the part of the directors.

1st interrogatory. Answers and says he did.

2d interrogatory. Answers and says he did agree that he should sign the notes as Vice-President in the month of April, 1855.

3rd interrogatory. Answers and says he did know that he signed them in the month of April.

Mr. John T. Sangston, being duly sworn by Mr. Thomas J. Earrickson, a Justice of the Peace in and for Caroline county, State of Maryland.

1st interrogatory. Answers and says he was a director. He was elected on the 6th day of January, 1855. He served as a director about two months.

2d interrogatory. Answers and says during the time this respondent was a director, S. Waggoner took notes on this bank, but to what amount he cannot say, without his consent, or any other director that he is aware of.
