An Act for uncertaine goods

19 All uncertaine goods to which no party justly
claimeth right shall be to the Lord Proprietarie or
his assignes & shall be sold at an outcry But
any party having right to the goods or to the
disposure of them claiming within three years
shall be restored to his right and the finder of
goods shall have the one half for his pains & charges

An Act providing against suddaine accidents
in the Governem^t

All Commissions from or under the Lord pro
proprietary which shall be in force at his death
shall remain in the same force untill a new
Commission for the Governem^t published under
the great Seal And in case the Lieuten^t Generall
shall decease or be absent out of the province
without nominating or substituting another
in his roome the first Council^l of State residing
at S^t Manies shall exercise the office of Lieuten^t
Generall in all points belonging to it untill his
return into the province or that another
be appointed by the Lord Proprietarie

An Act For Fencing of Ground

Every man shall fence his corne & other ground
against cattell at his own perill And the
owner of Swine may not be compelled to lan
his Swine This Act to endure for 2 years after
the end of this Assembly

An Act prohibiting the exportation of Lorne
No person shall export any Lorne or meale
(except for ship provision or that it be in exch^a
for a like quantity of Lorne imported unlesse
the rate of Lorne be estimated & sold at 30 To 6
