

Respectively yearly between the first of May & the first of September and to enquire by what means they may of the hands planting Tobacco in every Plantation and truly to certifye what quantity of Corne ground is planted and tended in every such plantation This Act to endure till the end of the next Assembly

An Act limiting the exportation of Corne
Noe Corne from ^{after} the midst of October in any yeare of the growth of the Province as well Indian as other may be exported out of the Province until the midst of February following at the soonest & at other time of the year noe such corne may be exported without the licence in writing of the Lieut^o Generall and Councell upon the consideration of the Store of the Country To which purpose one or more persons in every hundred appointed thereunto by the Lieuten^t Generall or Commander of any County calling to him one or two Neighbours shall at sometime in January yearly view the store or quantity of Corne then being in every family within the hundred and estimate the same and enquire and take the names or number of the persons belonging to every such family and certifye the same upon oath before the first of February yearly unto the Lieuten^t Generall or to the Commander of the County by him to be certified without delay to the Lieuten^t Generall
And all persons exporting or attempting to export before, or without such licence as aforesaid shall forfeit the Corne so exported or attempted to be exported or the value of it and it shall be judged out of the Province if it be sold or delivered to any Indians
This Act to endure till the end of the next Assembly
