Authority aforesaid that no person or persons whatsoever
Inhabitant or foreigner shall from and after the time
aforesaid upon any Lords day as aforesaid presume to
take fish in any Bay Port or Creek of or belonging to this
Province with any nets Trammels Saineshoots or
lines or any other instruments of fishing nor shall
command willfully suffer or permit any of his or their
Children hired Servants Servants or Slaves so to fish as
aforesaid And Be it likewise enacted by the authority
aforesaid that no person or persons from and after the
time aforesaid shall prophane or abuse the said Lords
day as aforesaid by Drunkenness Swearing Gaming
at Cards dice Bulliards Shuffell boards Bowles or
pinns horse race fowling or hunting or any other unlaw-
-full sports or recreations And if any person or persons
within this province from and after the end of the said
twenty dayes shall offend in all or any the premises
he shall forfeit and pay for every offence one hundred
pounds of Tobacco the said offences or any of them
being done in view of any Justice of Peace Magistrate
or other head Officer of any County City or Towne corporate
within their limitts respectively or being proved upon
oath by two or more witnesses or by the confession of
the person offending before any such Justice Magis-
trate or head officer within their severall limitts
respectively where in such offence shall be committed
to which end every such Justice Magistrate or head
officer shall have power by this act to administer
oath to such witnesses or witnesses any which
Sume or Sumes of Tobacco so forfeited as aforesaid shall
and may be executed and levied by the Sherife
under Sherife or constable by warrant to any one of
them directed from any such Justice or Justices of the
Peace Magistrate or other head Officers as aforesaid
within their severall limitts where all or any of the offences
aforesaid shall be committed or done by distresse &
Sale of the offenders goods rendering the party the
overplus or shall be recovered by any person or persons
that will sue for the same by bill plaint or Informacion
in any of his Lordships Courts of Record in this pro-
-vince all which forfeits shall be employed to and
for the use of the poor of the County Cities or boroughs
where
