WHEREAS by Experience it is found that want of ready
 money in this province is a very great hindrance & much impeded by
 thereof & without ready money no encouragement can be given to hand-
 =crafts and tradesmen either to come or continue in this province **Be**
it therefore Enacted by the right Hon. ^{the} Lord Prop.
 by & with the advice & consent of the upper & lower Houses of this province
 Gen. all Assembly & the authority of the same for the reasons aforesaid
