That all the Town and parts of Seavorne in Amaranthosa
County shall be bought or Valued by the Jury as before in this
Act is mentioned all that parcels or Acks of Land within Leasy
Neck Cove and Actons Cove lying and adjoining or nearly
Town Land as aforesaid or so much thereof as by the Com^{rs}
shall be found convenient to be fenced in and called the Town
Common or pasture and paid for and fenced in at the publick
Charge and shall be for the publick use and Service when need
shall require and that the Inhabitants of the said Towns -
shall not raise any Stock of Cattle or Hogs, Horses or Sheep -
more than what they can containe and raise upon their
respective Lot or Lots and not more at the discretion of
the Commissioners of the said Towns.
