Be it Enacted by the Queen most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice
and Consent of her Majesties Good Council and Assembly of this Province
and the Authority of the same That Christopher Smithers of the Port of Annapolis
Taylor as German Born and Arnold Lewis Taylor a Native of Holland &
John Sawert of Cecil County Gent

and Every of them shall from henceforth be adjudged reputed and taken as Natural
Born People of this Province and that they and Every of them by the Authorities afo
re Said be Enabled and adjudged to all intents and purposes to Demand Challenge ask
Have hold and Enjoy any Lands Tenements rents and Hereditaments to which they
Might in any wise be entitled as if they were free and Natural Born Subjects
and people: And also that they and every of them may and
May be Enabled to Maintain prosecute avow Justify and Defend all Manner
of Actions Sutes pleas Pleas and other demands whatsoever as liberally
frankly freely fully Law fully and Soundly as if they and every of them had
been Natural Born people and Subjects any Law Statute Usage or Custom to
the contrary in anywise notwithstanding

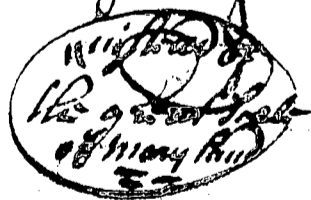
