 that shall purchase all or any of the said Lands of the Trustees and Com-  
 missioners aforesaid shall by virtue of such purchase have a firm and sure  
 Estate in fee of in and unto such Lands as shall by the said Trustees be  
 sold into them by virtue of this act any Law Statute or Usage to the contrary  
 notwithstanding and Be it enacted further by the authority aforesaid  
 that the said Sir William Widdrington Esq. John Wolf and W. Peter Dent  
 do forthwith upon the receiving the profits and Moneys by the sale of such  
 Lands pay and satisfy such damage unto the said Arnold Elroy and  
 Richard Chambers as they shall upon oath make appears to be due  
 to them and that they have sustained by reason of their becoming  
 Special Bailies as aforesaid.
