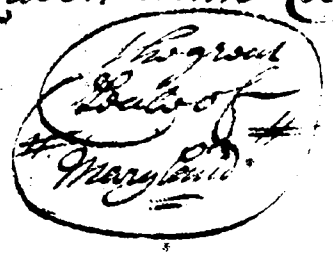

An Act Impowering Maj. Nicholas Lowe
Executor of the last will and testament of William Edmondson late of
Dorchester County to sell a certain tract of Land lying in
Dorchester County called Richardson's Choice formerly purchased
by the said William Edmondson of and from one John Nicholls
for payment of a debt due from the said William Edmondson to
the said John Nicholls for the remaining part of the Original
Purchase for the said Land.

Whereas the said William Edmondson in his life time
purchased from the said John Nicholls the said tract of Land
called Richardson's Choice lying near great Choptank river
in Dorchester County but the said William Edmondson dying
before payment of the Consideration of the said purchase
and not leaving assets sufficient to pay his debts the
said John Nicholls humbly prayed this Generall Assembly that
the said tract of Land might be sold to satisfy him what
remains due of the Consideration

Be it therefore enacted by the Queens most Excellent
Majesty by and with the advice and consent of her Majesty's
Governour Council and a Senate of this Province and the
authority of the same that the said Maj. Nicholas Lowe
Executor of the last will and testament of the said William
Edmondson doo shall be and is hereby authorized and empowered
