to be levied and raised by an Equall assessment on the
Taxable persons of this province and Collected and
paid by the severall Sherriffs of the respective Coun-
tyes as hath been usuall within this province.

Provided always that in case his Excellency the
Governour for the time being do Convene an
Assembly before the said first Tuesday of October
that then this present act and every Clause
therein contained shall be void & of noe Effect.

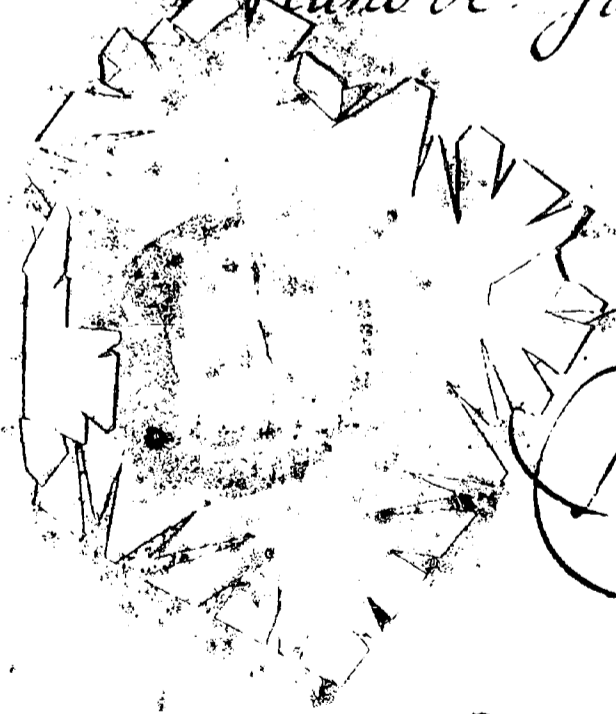
