An Act to Repeal a Certain Clause of one Act Entituled an Act  
ascertaining Fees to attorneys and practitioners of the Law in the Courts of this  
province and for Levying the Same by way of Execution  
Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and Consent  
of her maj<sup>ty</sup> Council and Assembly of this province and the authority of the same that a  
Certain Clause of one Act of Assembly made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at  
the City of Annapolis the Twentyninth day of November one thousand Seven hundred  
and Eight Entituled an Act ascertaining Fees to the attorneys and practitioners of the  
Law in the Courts of this province, And for Levying the Same by way of Execution  
in these words (that is to say) I PROVIDE always that nothing in this Act shall  
or be construed to extend to give Right to any Courts of this province to admit any attorn  
or other person practising the Law, to practice in any Court that had been already  
so to do by this Excellent Majesty and her maj<sup>ty</sup> hon<sup>ble</sup> Council be and is hereby utterly repealed  
made void
