 laws or Acts have been passed by the Major parts of our general Assembly there some in the full five thousand six hundred forty nine assented by
 assented unto by him we beinge very desirous in what wee maye to comely wth our said assembly from ^{whom} wee have a grante of writs for the parts of
 the said Acts or laws as wee approve of to bee gathered together in parchment and to bee hereunto annexed under our Great Seal all as moost
 or laws for annexed hereto as aforesaid And wee doe hereby wth the consent of the upper and lower house of our general Assembly there
 and requiringe our Lieutenant there for the tyme beinge to cause our Great Seal of the said Province to be affixed unto them and to send
 and the Islands therunto belonginge for the tyme beinge under the great seal of the said Province to be delivered And wee doe hereby give power to our Lieutenant
 hereunto shall signifye our or their pleasure to the contrary from tyme to tyme to consent in our name to any temporary lawes to continue in force
 or convenient for the good of our Colony there Notwithstandinge any thinge to the contrary in our Commission for you our said Lieutenant And
 Right Province Notwithstandinge that we have beene assented unto by our said Lieutenant there for the tyme beinge wth all in any kind be
 and assented unto by us as aforesaid or to any other lawes wher wee have formerly or shall hereafter assent unto by any speciall writ
 major parts of our general Assembly there or wth all as aforesaid or any waies touchinge upon any of the other prohibitions concern
 Commission to you our said Lieutenant there nor priviledge to any of our rights or dominion or in the said Province And wee
 unto in our name by our said Lieutenant there for the tyme beinge and consented unto from tyme to tyme by the major parts of
 the said shall continue in force in our said Province duringe the tyme to be respectively in them limited to continue but asse wee or our he
 under our or their hand and seal at Armes and use longer And wee doe also hereby give power to our said Lieutenant for the
 pleasure to the contrary wth the consent of the major parts of the upper and lower house respectively of our Great Assembly there
 hereafter shall be made wth in our said Province except in ye all and every the Acts or laws hereunto annexed as aforesaid and all
 any speciall writings under our or their hand and seal at Armes and published wth in our said Province none of w^{ch} wee will have
 assent therunto by some writings under our or their hand and Seal at Armes wth the consent from tyme to tyme of the
 there Given under our hand and seal at Armes the first daye of August in the first year of our said Majesty King James the first
