parts of our general Assembly there some in the year one thousand six hundred forty nine assented unto by our said Lieutenant William Stone and some in April last not yett
in what wee maye to comply wth our said assembly from ^{whom} wee fynde a grante of certayne parts of compaignes wth we whereof wee are very sensible have caused
to be published together in parchment and to be hereunto annexed under our Great Seal at Arms and signed alsoe by us declaringe hereby our assent unto the said
And we doe hereby wth the consent of the upper and lower house of our general Assembly there enact them to be laws in our said Province of Maryland wthlinge
the tyme beinge to cause our Great Seal of the said Province to be affixed unto them and to publish them as laws there to be observed by all people in our said Province
the tyme beinge under the penalty that if any contyned shall we doe hereby give power to our Lieutenant of our said Province of Maryland for the tyme beinge till we or our
he contrary from tyme to tyme to assent in our name to any temporary lawes to continue in force there for some certayne tyme only that hee shall fynde necessary
to stande any thinge to the contrary in our Commission to you our said Lieutenant William Stone Dated the first of August one thousand six hundred forty
nine assented unto by our said Lieutenant there for the tyme beinge wth shall in any kinde be contrary or repugnant to any of the Acts or Lawes hereunto annexed
other lawes wher we have formerly or shall hereafter assent unto by any speciall writinge under our hande & seals at Arms and consented unto by the
wth shall be repugnant or anywaies trenchinge upon any of the other prohibitions concerninge the power of assenting to lawes contyned in our said
nor prejudiciall to any of our rights or dominion over or in the said Province And we doe hereby declare that all such temporary lawes soe to assent
there for the tyme beinge and consented unto from tyme to tyme by the major parts of the upper and lower house respectively of our General Assembly
duringe the tyme to be respectively in them by s^hall be continued but if we or our heires shall declare our or their disassent sooner unto them (respectively
and not longer And we doe alsoe hereby give power to our said Lieutenant for the tyme beinge till we or our heires shall signifye our or their
the major parts of the upper and lower house (respectively of our General Assembly there from tyme to tyme to repeal any lawes already made or to
to exceptinge all and every the Acts or Lawes hereunto annexed as aforesaid and all others wher we or our heires shall assent unto by us or our heires by
hande & seals at Arms and published in our said Province none of w^{ch} we or our heires shall have repealed or altered wth out our or our heires speciall and expresse
in their hande and seals at Arms wth the consent from tyme to tyme of the major parts of the upper and lower house (respectively of our general
