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An Act of Repeal of all Laws heretofore made in this Province and conforming
all Laws made this General Assembly

Be it Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majestys by and with
the Advice and Consent of this Present General Assembly that all Laws heretofore made in this
Province be and forever hereby stand repealed annulled and void, and that all Laws now made
and Assented to this Present General Assembly (and no other) be and remain in full
Force and Power according to the True Intent and meaning thereof and that the same be
accounted and Esteemed as the Body of the Laws of this Province and no other heretofore made
Provided always that this Law shall not extend or be construed to make void any
Persons Right by Acts of Statute Affections or any other Private Acts heretofore made
Relating to and Private Persons but that the same be hereby kept and Preserved to them
according to the True Intent and meaning thereof anything herein to the contrary
Notwithstanding
