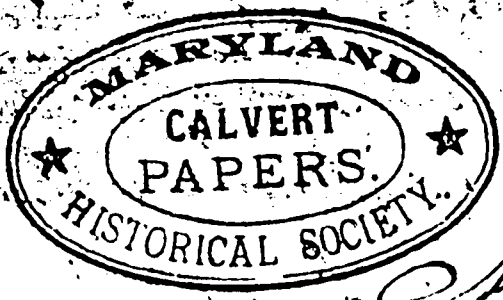

An Act for recording the Journall
of the lower house

1)

Whereas it is thought good for the benefit
in lighting of future Assemblies that a Re-
cord be kept of all proceedings that shall passe
in the lower house of Assembly in this Province
Be it therefore enacted by the R^t hon^{ble} the
Lord Proprietor by and with the Assent of
the upper and lower house of this present
Generall Assembly that every Clerk of the
lower house for the time being transferre
the said Journall within two months after the
dissolution prorogation or Adjournment of saye
said Assembly and deliver the same into the
Secretarys Office upon the penalty of five
hundred pounds of tobacco to the Lord Propri-
etor and the loss of his Salary for his be-
- being in that Assembly the said sume and for
- future to be levied upon the said Clerk by ap-
- payment of the Lieutenant Generall or Go-
- vernour of this Province for the same being
- upon Certificate from the Secretary of the Province
- being for the time being that the said Journall
- as aforesaid is not by the Clerk of the lower
