

Tobacco to Philip Lynes more four thousand Eight hundred seventy two pounds
Tobacco to Major Thomas Bayton three thousand hundred and fifty one pounds of
Tobacco and whereas there is before in this act mentioned seven hundred and
twenty pounds of Tobacco to be paid to each of the severall Sheriffs, of an dunn
Dolla Baltimore Cecil Kent Sealtott Dorchester and James sett Counties It is
the true intent and meaning of this act that the same is intended towards pay-
ment of a rate and one half of each County that attended upon the Delegates
and Representatives of the said Counties to this present Generall assembly and
further that there be paid and satisfied to the severall Sheriffs of this Province
for their salary for collecting the sume of four hundred and five thousand six
hundred and eighty pounds of Tobacco the sume of forty thousand five hundred
sixty eight pounds of Tobacco and be it further enacted by the advice consent
and authority aforesaid that the aforesaid sume of Tobacco amounting in the
whole to the sume of four hundred forty six thousand two hundred forty eight
pounds of Tobacco be levied and assessed by an equal assessment upon the
persons and Estates of the Inhabitants of this Province and be paid to the sever-
all persons to whom the sume is due according to the accounts disbursements
and necessary Charges of this Province which have been examined stated
and allowed by the Upper and Lower Houses of this present Generall Assembly
any law Custom or Statute to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

A further Additionall Act to the act for advancement of trade and to
the supplementary act to the same

Whereas by an act lately made at a Generall assembly begun and hold at the Ridge
in an arundell County the sixene day of October in the yeare of our Lord one thousand
six hundred Eighty and three Entitled an act for advancement of trade and by one
other act made the same assembly hold at the City of St Maries the four and twenty
toke day of aprile in the yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred Eighty and four
Entitled an additionall and supplementary act to the act for advancement of trade
It was enacted that the severall respective hower ports and places in the said acts
mentioned shall be ports and places wherall ships and vessels trading into this
Province shall be laden and put on shore and sold buyed and traffick all goods
wares and Commodities that shal be imported into this Province and likewise
that all Tobaccoes wares and Manufactures of the Province produced and man-
ufactured of this Province intended to be sold here or transported out of this
Province shall be that the true intent be brought to the said ports
