whatsoever stranger or Inhabitant within this Province shall export or attempt
to export out of this Province any of the aforesaid Coyne or money for advanced
as aforesaid or the pence of forfeiture of the said money soe exported or intended to
be exported as aforesaid one halfe or moiety thereof to the Right Honorable
our Prom. in the other halfe to the Informer or him or them that shall sue
for the same in any Court of Record within this Province by bill plaint or Infor
macion whom noe Coyne protection or wagar of law to be allowed Provided that no
thing in this act shall be taken or construed to alter the lawes already made and
provided in reference to his Coyne but that his Coyne shall be taken and received
his coin fines for all moneys and his Impression of two shillings p the and all othe
Duties to him payable in full manner and forme as the same is already provided
for to all intents and purposes as if this act had never been made and be it further
enacted by the authority aforesaid that all Officers what soever bearing holding or
enjoying any place of profit under the Right Honorable our Prom. in this
Province who make any fees or payes and or shall be legally due and payable for
any executing or performing any matter or thing belonging to their respo
sibilities Officers and all and every of the said Ordinary Keepers within this
Province shall not refuse to receive at all and every of them are hereby obliged
to receive the rate of six shillings of such advanced Coyne as
of every hundred pounds of soldeed
