

13 See. Obliged to put out all Male Orphan Children Apprentices
to some of the Tradesmen and Inhabitants in y^e Ports Towns,
if such Tradesmen and Inhabitants can be found and will take
Such Orphans and not to any person or persons whatsoever
which said Tradesmen and Inhabitants of Ports and Towns
shall be Subject to y^e Conditions and Agreements to be made
with them by y^e Comm^{rs} of y^e County Courts on behalf of such
Male Orphans as other persons that take Orphans have or
ought to be and shall, and are hereby Obliged to perform
the Same;

And be it further enacted & declared
By the Authority advice and Consent afores^d. that nothing
in this Act shall Oblige or be Construed to Oblige any person
or persons whatsoever. his. her. or their heirs or Assigns that
formerly hath taken up and built upon any Lott or Lots
in the Ports Towns or places afores^d. by vertue of any former
Law or Act of Assembly again to remove or take up such
Lott or Lots so as aforesaid formerly taken up and built
upon; but that these their heirs and Assigns shall and may
have hold and Enjoy the Same as if this Act had nev^r been made

And be it likewise enacted by the
Authority Advice and Consent afores^d. that any person or
persons whatsoever that shall Offend Act or do Contrary to
this present Act or y^e true intent and meaning thereof in
any Case for which no fine or forfeiture is before in and
by this Act imposed. he she or they so Offending shall for-
feit and pay to our Sovereign Lady the Queen Majesty
her heirs and Successors the Several Sums of Tobacco
following (that is to say) Every Sheriff or his Deputy five
thousand pounds of Tobacco. Every Marall Officers Collector
or their Deputies Ten thousand pounds of Tobacco. Every
Clerk of the County Court or his Deputy five thousand
pounds of Tobacco. the Collector's Receiv^r of y^e said Balti-
more's Revenues or their Deputies Ten thousand
