An Arbitrat. whereof is as followeth (Viz) first,

It is Ordered by the P^r Comm^d that a Street or Strand of three perches
broad be laid out upon y^e River and Cooke side (Viz) beginning at
y^e said Little Marshie Crooke and from thence running along y^e said
River side to y^e Mouth of y^e said Cambridge Crooke and up the said
Crooke to y^e Mouth of the Little Cove (Viz) to the lot No. four teen
which is drawn & staked out according by which word it is Agreed
that y^e Surveyor Regis lay out Lot upon the Strand on y^e River
side beginning at y^e P^r Mouth Crooke which he doth and are Numbered
as followeth (Viz) 69: 88: 87: 86: 85: 84: 83: 82: 81: 79: -

And the Comm^d do further Order that the P^r Surveyor Regis lay
out a Street of three perches broad to begin at y^e P^r River side at
y^e P^r lot 79 and runn South degrees West by to y^e utmost Stone
of y^e said Land which Street y^e P^r Comm^d do Name and Ord. the same be
called by the Name of High street which Street is layd out according
by then the Comm^d Ord. the P^r Surveyor Regis to lay out Lots between
the said Street and Cambridge Crooke upon y^e P^r River side which he
doth as followeth (Viz) beginning at y^e Street upon y^e River side
1: 2: 3: 4: 5: which being layd out marked and staked as before the P^r
