and be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty

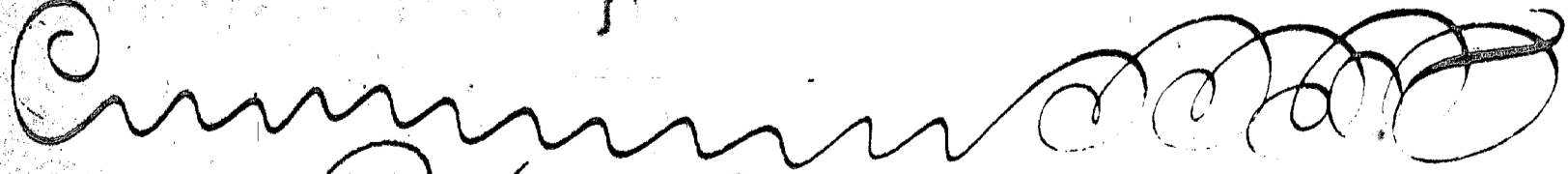
by and with the advice and Consent of her Majesty's ^{Privy} Council and Assembly

ever a good sure and justifiable Estate of Inheritance in fee simple, &
to execute and perform all the trusts reposed in the said Decedent, ac-
tually and effectually to all intents and purposes, as if the said Decedent
were all living and did or should Joyn in the performing the said
will and that he shall and may and is hereby authorized and
Impowered and Obliged to apply the money or moneys arising by
such sale or sales to the Uses in the said will appointed any Acts, Statute
Usage or Custome or want of Authority to do by the words in the said
Last will & Testament of the said John Edmondson to the Contrary
Notwithstanding That it is well that this Act nor any thing therein
Contained shall extend or be construed to extend to enable the said Thomas
to make sale of any lands, tenements or Hereditaments which were
pernant to the Tenor of the will aforesaid disposed of Aliened, or sold to any
person or persons whatsoever jointly by William and James Edmondson Deced
