 adjournment from the end of this present session of Assembly until they
 shall fully finish and comply with what is required of them by this Act and
 to order the payment thereof to the severall persons to whom it is allowed
 in the same Journalls of accounts according to the severall and respective
 allowances to them therein made and also to order the said sume of three
 hundred forty four pounds and nine pence in money out of the publick Stock
 of this province in Treasurers hands to the severall persons to whom the same
 is allowed in the said Journalls according to their severall and respective
 allowances to ~~be~~ them therein made as aforesaid and also that the said
 Committee as aforesaid appointed do Levy raise & order such further sumes of
 money and Tobacco as shall be sufficient to defray the Necessary Charge
 of the said Committee according to their usuall & Lawfull Allowances &
 no more to be Raised Levy & Ordered and paid as aforesaid and
 the sume of tobacco that shall be so apportioned per poll by the said
 Committee shall be Levyed by way of Execution upon the body Goods or Chattels
 of every taxable person within this province by the severall Sheriffs
 of the respective Counties in such manner as by other Laws of this
 province is Directed and provided and that Writts of Execution be to that
 end accordingly issued by any of her Majesties Justices of the Province
 Court under their hand and Seal or under their hand and the Seal of any
 said Committee transmit a fair Journall of all their proceedings to the Clerk
 of Assembly within convenient time to be Lodged in the Assembly office
 for the satisfaction of all persons therewith Concerned
