

And Act declaring all laws heretofore made which have been enacted this Session of Assembly to be repealed

Whereas sundry laws of this province have been enacted this present Session many whereof are not particularly repealed by the laws remaining therein therefore for the better ascertaining what laws are in force it is hereby declared and enacted -

And be it Enacted by the Kings most Excellent Majesty and with the advice and Consent of his Majesty's Governor Council and Assembly of this province and the authority of the same that all such laws or Acts of Assembly heretofore made which have been considered and enacted this present Session be and are hereby declared to be repealed abrogated null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever -

Provided always that nothing in this act shall be construed to extend to the prejudice of any action or suit already commenced in any of the Courts of this province but that the same shall and may be adjudged and determined in such manner as if this act had not past -
