 for the Land Chancery and provinciall Records in the sume of one thousand
 .said pounds Current money and the Commissary for the records in the
 Commissarys Office in the sume of one thousand pounds Current money
 All which bonds shall be Conditioned as follows Viz^t The Condition of
 this above writton Obligation is such that if the above Bound
 whilst he shall continue in the office of _____ Shall at his own
 proper Cost and Charges find a supply of good and sufficient record books neces-
 :ry for the Entering up of all matters and things relating to such _____ Office
 and shall duely and Carefully Look after preserve and maintaine all the
 Severall books of records now being and remaining in the said Office as also
 those that from time to time shall be added thereto in such manner as y^e
 when _____ shall be Dismissed from officiating longer in the said Office shall
 deliver all the aforesaid Records to the next person that succeeds in the said
 Office in good order and repair according to y^e true intent and meaning of
 the act of Assembly in that Case made and Provided that then the above
 Written Obligation is to be Voyd and of no Effect otherwise to remaine in
 full force and Vertue in Law. The which bond being so Entered into and taken
 by two Justices of the provinciall Court as aforesaid they shall Immediately
 Call before them the Wittneses to said bond or bonds and Cause a probate
 thereof to be made before them which they shall Endorse or Cause to be
 Endorsed on y^e back of the said Bond or Bonds with order Immediately to Enter
 the said Bond with the Endorsement in the provinciall Land Records which be
 Immediately performed by the proper Clerk and after such Entry upon record
 the Originall bond is to be Immediately lodged with the Clerk of the Council
 m^y Council Office who is hereby requir^d to take Charge of the Same and that an Attes-
 :ted Copy of the said bond from the said Provinciall records shall be as good
 Evidence in Law to maintain any action of debt to be brought for the
 breach of the Condition thereof to all intents and purposes as if the origi-
 nall bond were actually produced in such Case Provided that altho
 such officers have Entered into bonds with Surety as aforesaid the Entering into
 such bonds shall not be Deemed a Compliance with the directions of this
 Act at any time after the Sufficiency of such Sureties shall be Disappro-
 ved of by the Justices of the provinciall Court in Court sitting but that in
 Case of such Disapprobation the officer or officers aforesaid shall be obliged
 to Enter into new bond in forme aforesaid with such Sureties as the said
 Provinciall
