

Honorable the Lord Proprietary by and with y^r Advice and Consent of His Lordships Governor and of Upper and Lower houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same that from and after the publication hereof the Justices of Each County in Countalting so and are hereby Empowered & Authorized from time to time as often as need shall require to grant Licences to such person or persons as they shall think fitt to be Ordinary keepers & Inholders for the keeping of Ordinarys & houses of Entertainment so long time and in such and so many places within their severall and respective Countys for the Ease and Conveniency of the Inhabitants Travellers and Strangers as to them respectively shall seem meet For which Licences the said persons that shall be so licenced to keep Ordinary as aforesaid at y^r time off his and their taking such Licences Enter into recognizance to his Lordship y^r Lord Proprietary for the payment of the severall and respective sums following that is to say for every Licence to keep Ordinary in the city of Annapolis y^r sume of one thousand pounds of tobacco the Lordship and at any other place within this province y^r sume of five hundred pounds of tobacco for every year such persons shall keep Ordinary as aforesaid to be paid as aforesaid for which said Licence and recognizance the party or parties taking the same shall pay to y^r Clerk of each Respective County Court the sume of thirty pounds of tobacco and no more —

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that the Justices of the severall County Courts be and are hereby authorized & Empowered at their severall County Courts in the month of August yearly or oftener as they shall think fitt and Every year having summoned each respective Ordinary keeper within their Respective Countys ther and there to sett and Abof^t the rates and prices of all Liquors and other accomodations whatsoever by them the said Ordinary keepers to be Vend^d for y^r year Ensuing and so yearly and Every year which rates and prices of all Liquors so to be sold and Abof^t limited and appointed by the Justices aforesaid shall be by their severall and respective hands transcribed and sett up at the severall and respective County Courts in some publick places ther that Every person or persons may peruse y^r same y^r copy of which Table price of Liquors and accomodations Every Ordinary keeper within Each County moste obliged to Transcribe farrly and keep the same sett up in the publick places of
